

Polígonos of the Uco Valley is a selection that expresses the particular characteristics of different terroirs within the Valley. These are wines from a selection of vineyards that account for the differences in altitude, soil and climate that currently characterize the subregions of San Pablo, Paraje Altamira and Tupungato.



WINE DATA:

GRAPE COMPOSITION: 100% Malbec

Zuccardi Polígonos

APPELLATION: San Pablo, Valle de Uco, Mendoza

San Pablo Malbec 2022

VINIFICATION: Maceration done in concrete vats (no epoxi) with indigenous yeast.

Maceration for 20 days. The wine was aged in concrete vats.

ALTITUDE: 4,593 ft / 1,400 mt above sea level

SOIL TYPE: Alluvial, sandy - loamy, with layers of gravel covered with calcium carbonate at variable depth

ALCOHOL: 13 % | TOTAL ACIDITY 5.60 g/l | RESIDUAL SUGAR 1.80 g/l

TASTING NOTES:

COLOR: Red color with violet hues.

AROMA: Expresses a great herbal character with notes of fresh red fruits.

FLAVOR: Lively acidity and subtlety of tannins in the mouth.
