Intense fruity with rich scent of apple, lemon and grapefruit. A pronounced aroma of wisteria in bloom and acacia flowers. The floral aromas clash with a pleasantly bitter citrus rind note that is inherent in Prosecco grape (glera). Vivid and fresh, with a fine, persistent perlage.

Orvieto Classico DOC Organic 2023

This wine reveals a straw-yellow color, with greenish hues. Its aroma is notably fruity, featuring delicate traces of citrus, green apple, and fragrant acacia flowers. The flavor profile is both light and vibrant, achieving a delightful equilibrium between sweetness and freshness. Nuances of lemon, grapefruit, and pear stand out, interwoven with a subtle hint of honey, which concludes with a lingering mineral undertone on the palate.

"A warming high street red with instant appeal thanks to the silky richness of partially dried grapes. If you're a fan of Italian Amarone or Ripasso and looking for an affordable kitchen table alternative, this could be right up your street... This non-vintage blend is cleverly constructed to deliver affordable grandeur and while it appears a touch pale in the glass, don't be discouraged. This red has plenty of sweet fruitcake aromas and is gorgeously silky to sip with dried cherries and cranberries, a hint of sultana and a pleasing bite to the finish that falls somewhere between a sundried tomato and a cherry skin. Thanks to its lean intensity it's great to pair with bold game dishes from wild boar to venison, also fab with a cheeseboard."
