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**HUMO BLANCO Organic/Biodynamic Pinot Noir 2022**

"Lurton likes Pinot from California and has tried to replicate the style in Chile, but finally he harvested early for the 2022 Humo Blanco Edición Limitada Pinot Noir, which fermented with some stems and still achieved 14% alcohol. The wine is not very varietal, and it feels juicy-ripe, fruit-driven, straightforward and easy to drink. Drink Date: 2022 - 2024."

"The 2022 Pinot Noir Humo Blanco Edición Limitada from Lolol, Colchagua Costa, was aged in 1/3 French oak barrels. Ruby-red with a purple sheen. The fruit-forward nose offers notes of strawberry and pomegranate with hints of herbs and bloody aromas. Ripe in the mouth, with alcoholic energy and a smooth texture. The fruity finish lingers at length. Drinking Window: 2023 - 2034."

The wines produced are vinified from grapes produced on two estate properties: the 26 hectare Lolol estate vineyard and the 15 hectare Chomedaue vineyard further down in the Colchagua Valley.

"Lots of lifted aromas of fresh fruit, such as currants and blackberries, as well as flowers, following through to a medium body, fine and silky tannins and a vivid finish. Carmenere, syrah, cabernet sauvignon and cabernet franc. Drink or hold."
