Zuccardi Serie A Malbec 2022

"The varietal Serie A range includes wines from the "Argentinean" varieties, and the star of this range is, of course, the 2022 Serie A Malbec. Here they search for typicity from Valle de Uco, with freshness and flowers, red rather than black fruit, nice tannic structure and purity; they are not looking for complexity or limestone but varietal character, at which this excels. This has juiciness and structure and is fine-boned. It is very different from the Bonarda in this range."

"There's even more juiciness in the 2020 Serie A Bonarda than in the 2019, always being careful to avoid over-ripeness. This has some more tannin in this generous vintage, more like 2017 than 2018. There are plenty of aromatic herbs, and the wine feels very young. Drink 2021-2023."

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Zuccardi Q wines are of the highest quality, made from the oldest vines, of up to 40 years of age, under supervision of a specialized viticultural team (that actually marks the individual vines destined for this line with a 'Q' for 'Quality'). These wines see 10 – 16 months in oak and are only made in vintages of exceptional quality.

Zuccardi Q Chardonnay 2022

"The 2022 Q Chardonnay is one of the pillars of this range from selected villages in the Valle de Uco, here El Peral and Gualtallary (explained on the back label). This is where the wines get serious; they go beyond fruit and juiciness to look for more complexity and more sense of place through selecting the places. This fermented in concrete and used 500-liter barrels (50% each) where it matured for some six months, but there's no oak here; there's purity, nuance and complexity, freshness (no malolactic and no bâtonnage) and a fine texture with chalky tannins. It has 13.5% alcohol and full development of flavors and aromas but with freshness and tension."

2023 "The 2023 Chardonnay Zuccardi Q comes from Gualtallary and El Peral in the Uco Valley. Half of the wine was aged in 500-liter used barrels, while the other half remained in concrete vats. Bright yellow in color, it offers aromas of pear and acacia with an enticing herbal note and a hint of ginger. Dry and lean, the taut, malic palate is lightly concentrated and refreshing. This high-altitude white is leaner than in previous vintages."

Zuccardi Q Tempranillo 2018

"They want to keep the Tempranillo for longer before it's released, so the current vintage from the Q range is the 2018 Q Tempranillo. This comes from Santa Rosa in the traditional part of Mendoza, mentioned on the label, a historical wine here with pergola vines planted some 40 years ago by the grandfather of the current generation. He likes the wine after some time in bottle, a little like the wines from Rioja in Spain, matured in well-seasoned 225-liter French oak barrels. So, it has a slightly different style from the rest of the range, with spiciness from the élevage, notes of tobacco and a sensation of sweetness, ripeness with control, 14% alcohol and a velvety mouthfeel."

"A bright, rich purple in the glass. The initially reductive nose delivers pure fruit flavors of ripe plum and blackberry before opening out into sweet and sour cherry with hints of herbs. Makes a broad entrance before the mild flow and juicy freshness, while the variety's sweet tannins join forces with the gentle chalk to produce a pleasant, compact feel. The warm year accounts for a good measure of the structure and volume, resulting in a long-lasting, juicy and flavorful wine."

José Zuccardi 2018

"The 2018 José Zuccardi mixes Malbec from different regions in the Valle de Uco (today, Altamira and Gualtallary) all with limestone soils. It always has a touch of Cabernet Sauvignon (only 5% to 10%), which is not mentioned on the label, and is now matured in foudre for two years. I tasted this next to the 2019, where there are no differences other than the nuances from the year, with similar alcohol and acidity, but the sensation is of a little wider and powerful in the 2018. The wine feels very stable and harmonious after the long élevage, but there are no traces of oak. It's serious and powerful, expressive and open, with a round and full palate and great persistence."

The 2023 reveals subtle herbal aromas of vermouth, lavender and herbs with a hint of hops. Broad and fairly rich, with good tension on the palate, it finishes with a touch of green apple. A true reflection of its origins, its chalky texture defines the mouthfeel."

"The wine hails from San Pablo in Uco Valley. In this cold vintage, both white and red wines from this appellation show complexity. This Chardonnay starts with an enticing nose of wet stone, white blossoms and a touch of ginger. The citrus and textured palate includes notes of Meyer lemon, clementine and dried herbs. There is a light saline note in the delicious finish."

2023 "The 2023 Chardonnay Fósil is a statement of intent—a vineyard planted in San Pablo with the aim of producing great wine. Ever since its first release, the 2016 vintage, Fósil has quickly established itself as a high-altitude white with a refreshing, non-ripe profile. Even in a warm vintage like 2023, the Chardonnay Fósil offers herbal and reductive notes, with hints of huacatay (a native Andean herb) alongside lime and lemon, all set against a soft backdrop of linden blossom. Lean and vibrant, the palate is pure and chalky in texture, flowing with a light, compact feel. The 2023 vintage solidifies its terroir-driven character."

Poligonos San Pablo Albariño 2022

"This is the second vintage of albariño for the Poligonos line, and it comes from the vineyards that the Zuccardi family planted in 2013 in the San Pablo zone, up against the first mountain chains of the Andes, about 1,400 meters above sea level. This is totally marked by citrusy, juicy acidity that funnels freshness to this albariño from the mountains, a place that's not at all common in a variety that always faces the sea. Here there are herbs, ripe white fruits, and a lot of freshness."

Poligonos Tupungato Sauvignon Blanc 2022

"The pungent 2022 Poligonos Tupungato Sauvignon Blanc from La Carrera (but La Carrera is not yet an IG or appellation) is from a parral that is around 30 years old and planted at 1,550 meters above sea level, where the grapes have pungent flavors of fig. They started vinifying this in 2019 (but I never tasted it until today). It has a similitude with the one produced by Matias Riccitelli, with lots of aromatic herbs and pungent herbal notes, tomato vine, green peas and beans and citrus notes. It has very tasty flavors and is almost salty, with 12.5% alcohol and extremely high acidity (10.4) and freshness (pH 3.1). It fermented in concrete with some skin contact (very short) to extract the aromatic compounds from the skins but without making an orange wine... Superb. It should develop nicely in bottle."

Poligonos San Pablo Cabernet Franc 2019

"There was an acute note of freshly cracked black peppercorns in the nose of the 2019 Poligonos San Pablo Cabernet Franc, which matured in foudre. They use oak for Cabernet Franc, which they feel needs more oxygen than the Malbec, which matures in concrete. The grape is very transparent to the place, despite being a very aromatic and recognizable variety. It has a very fine thread, refined tannins and a lack of fruit, with dry flowers. Zuccardi Aluvional Gualtallary Malbec 2019

"The 2019 Aluvional Gualtallary comes from the section people call Monasterio, although the official division of subzones has not yet been approved. This is always the wildest (Sebastián Zuccardi calls it Wildtallary...), with an explosive nose of wild herbs and flowers, thyme, rockrose and lavender, interwoven with violets and coupled with a laced texture with very fine-grained, chalky tannins, showcasing what the zone can do and why it was made famous. They harvest by soil, because it's not all the same, and they look for mid-palate depth using parts where they have caliche stones but also a little bit of clay, just below the hills (los cerros). Their main work here is to avoid exuberance and give it restraint, and it comes through as refined and slender; if you let the grapes ripen too much, you can have heavier aromas reminiscent of black olives, of which there's nothing here. They do a gentler second half of the fermentation, just wetting the cap with buckets (by hand) and avoiding cold fermentations. It seems to work wonders... Simply superb, this is super elegant but in an austere, tight and precise way."

Zuccardi Finca Las Cerrilladas 2019

"A new red in the "Fincas" single-vineyard range, the 2019 Finca Las Cerrilladas was produced with grapes from Gualtallary and is an intense and aromatic red with the wild profile from Gualtallary. It has 14.5% alcohol and is ripe and juicy, with very good acidity and freshness. It seems to me like there's more consistency in Gualtallary than in Altamira. They have 25 to 30 plots on the property, different soils and exposures, different ways of pruning, too; they deconstruct the property, vinifying everything separately, and then they build the wine through blending, like they do for all the Finca wines. Like the rest of their bottlings, they only use concrete and indigenous yeasts for the fermentation and aging of the wine, but here they use less full clusters, perhaps between 30% to 50%. There's a different tactile sensation from Altamira, and this is firmer, with more severe tannins. Here, the challenge is to avoid over-ripeness, and they have managed nicely. Drink Date: 2024 - 2032."

"They use some specific soils for the 2017 Finca Piedra Infinita, up to eight different plots, but not all plots contribute to the wine every vintage; in general, the zones with 20 to 60 centimeters of soil and then large stones with calcium carbonate are reflected in the wines. So, they deconstruct the vineyard, and then they build the blend with the plots they like for each wine, up to eight here. There's a little more ripeness and exuberance here within the general austerity of the whole Piedra Infinita range, especially when compared with the 2018s. They harvested 15 to 20 days earlier than in 2018 (or in 2016) and they had to run, but the separation they have by soil helped them to harvest earlier the earlier-ripening parts of the vineyard. That gave them a great advantage and they produced very good 2017s, but the condition of the year, a shorter cycle and a more hurried year was what it was. This 2017 is not as long as the 2018, and there is a strong chalkiness in the finish. Drink 2021 - 2028."
